<p><u>Format</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Format will be dependent on number of teams entered. <p><u>Timings</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Timings will be dependent on number of teams entered. <p><u>Equipment</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Kwik cricket stumps and bats etc. <p><u>Rules</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Players bat in pairs for 2 overs Each fielder must bowl with the wicket keeper rotating All players bowl from the same end No 'leg before wicket' (lbw) rule Bowling can be overarm or underarm 2 runs for a wide or no ball but no extra ball to be bowled except in the final over of each innings Teams start on 200 runs Traditional cricket scoring applies except that when players are out they carry on batting but receive a minus 5 run penalty. The side scoring the most runs wins In the event of injury to a player, a substitute will be allowed to field, but not bowl. Players can score runs (running between the wickets or from wide or no ball) and lose runs (being bowled, caught or run out). The length of the wicket is 10m. Outdoor boundary - 30 metre circle
